What can be recycled at our curbside:

1. These types of paper phone books, 2-ply (corrugated cardboard, white paper, and newspapers.
2. All plastic containers that have the numbers 1-7 in the recycling symbol.
3. Styrofoam is the only plastic that is not recycled in the curbside bin, or at the landfill.
4. These kinds of cans: metal food cans and aluminum drink cans.
5. It is best to newspaper containers so they don't stink and collect bugs, even though it's not required.
6. Paper and plastic labels do not need to be removed.
